

Health Ministries Safety Announcement



If someone collapses here at St. Paul's United Methodist Church the most important first step is to call 911 immediately and clearly state the church's name and location. While help is on the way, be aware of the lifesaving tools available throughout the building.

AED (Automated External Defibrillator) can provide a critical shock to restore a normal heart rhythm in the event of sudden cardiac arrest that is located in the Fellowship Hall.

A choking rescue device is also available if someone is unable to breathe due to an obstruction in 3 locations: pulpit, Sunday school office and in the kitchen in the first aid drawer.

In addition to the choking rescue device in the kitchen, a well-stocked first aid kit can be used for injuries or urgent needs until professional help arrives.

The Health Ministries team, in collaboration with the congregation, is working to ensure we are prepared for any emergencies that may arise at church. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with where these items are located and always follow emergency protocols—quick action saves lives.
